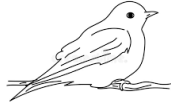

Youth Drop-in

In October of 2021 we launched the first Youth Drop-In night at CCI's Cyber Cafe, offering free tutoring, games, and dinner. The Southern Connected Communities Project (SCCP) will be hosting these youth drop in nights every Tuesday from 4-8pm. The youth drop-in is a safe space, where school kids ages 8 and up are welcome to come, learn, relax, and enjoy the space. SCCP has worked to ensure that an adult will be present each night. Youth can get help doing homework, applying to college, make use of the library, play board and card games, or watch movies together. The hope is that the space will become one where young people feel welcomed to come do work and learn with each other. Snacks are provided
