Beginning July 2, 2019 we will be open Tuesdays 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. and Thursdays 5 p.m. to 9 p.m.


Beginning August 6, 2019 hours will be Tuesdays and Thursdays 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.

# BIG BUG BONANZA







### New Bridge in Eagan

As many in the community know that the bridge crossing the Clearfork River to CCI is not up to state safety standards; and is falling apart. The state is in the process of totally remodeling the bridge; meaning that the bridge is going to be removed and rebuilt. A temporary bridge is being constructed to direct traffic during the demolition and rebuilding process. When asked how long the project will last TDOT (Tennessee Department of Transportation) responded: "The contractor (Potters South East) was given a Notice to Proceed on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 and has one hundred twenty (120) days to complete the project. All work should be completed on or before October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2019."
