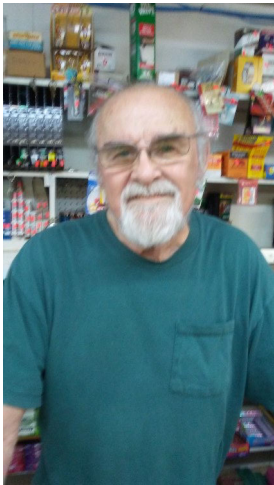
Second Year for Camp Clearfork

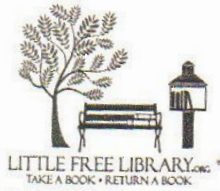
