Heating Assistance

Do you need help paying high electric or gas bills? Maybe ETHRA can help. The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is designed to help eligible low income households pay for high energy costs. LIHEAP will provide a one time benefit to eligible households. Assistance can be applied to your electric bill, gas (natural or electric) bill, oil, kerosene, wood, coal and LP gas. Beginning October 3, 2016 ETHRA will begin taking applications for their LIHEAP program. To apply you must fill out an application and provide copies of your birth certificate and/or state ID, social security cards for all household members, proof of all income dated 2016 (bank statements **are not** accepted), 12 month printout from your electric company that shows usage and dollar amount (must have current electric bill if name and address is not on print out), any receipts from wood, coal LP gas, etc. You can get an application by calling 1-844-309-0416 (Campbell or Claiborne County), or by going online to www.ethra.org/publications/2014LIHEAPapp.pdf
